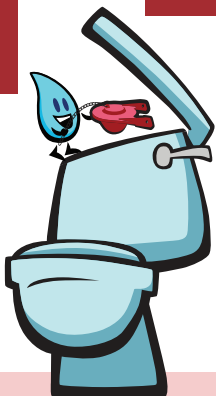
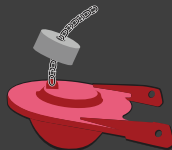


Here's an Easy Fix to Save Water...

Did you know the rubber flapper in a toilet tank should be replaced at least **every five years**? An old, worn flapper can cause your toilet to silently leak thousands of gallons of water each year. Replacing a flapper is an easy do-it-yourself task that can save water and lower your utility bill. Before you install a new flapper though, take a photo of the inside of your tank and buy the same type. It may have a foam float that needs replacement too.
